

On Friday, June 13, Weaver Academy added 53 names to its list of amazing alumni! The Commencement Ceremony was held at the Special Events Center of the First Horizon Coliseum at 2:00pm.

Members of the Class of 2025 earned more than \$14.1 million in scholarships and contributed 6,433 service-learning hours to their communities. Graduates will attend four-year colleges and universities (91%), two-year community colleges (8%), and one percent (1%) will attend trade school, enter the workforce, or take a gap year. More than half the graduates intend to pursue the arts in their post-secondary plans.

ATTENTION PARENTS OF JUNIORS> North Carolina law requires that 12th graders receive the MCV (meningococcal vaccine) and proof must be submitted within 30 days of the first day of school. Students in non-compliance are excluded from school. If your child has received the required MCV, provide proof from a health care provider or clinic so school records may be updated. A print copy may be brought to the Counseling Office, or you may email a scanned copy of the documentation to jonesm3@gcsnc.com.
