**Students who complete Driver Education behind-the-wheel training must have a Driving Eligibility Certificate (DEC) from Weaver Academy to present to the N.C. Department of Motor Vehicles when applying for a Learner's Permit.** The **DEC is valid for 30 days** and **requires a parent signature**. **Call Mrs. Jones in the Counseling Office for an appointment to get the Driving Eligibility Certificate.**

**PVA student drivers must purchase and display a Weaver parking permit. Completed vehicle information cards must be signed by the student and parent/guardian and submitted with \$50 payment or online payment receipt. CTE student drivers do not have to purchase an additional Weaver parking permit; however, they must display the parking permit from their home school AND complete the vehicle information card.**
