

Comprehensive Needs Assessment

For the 2020-2021 school year, The Middle College at Bennett went through some significant changes over the past two years. The school has gone from serving students in grades nine through twelve to serving twelfth grade only. This change impacted the school size; MC@Bennett has gone from 126 to 25 students. Currently the Middle College at Bennett has three teachers; History, Math and Science. During the 2020-2021 school year; there were 5 teachers inclusive of the three from this year along with a History and an Exceptional Children' teacher.

Last year we tested 14 students in Biology with 35.7% proficiency rate with an ACT proficiency rate of 60%. This year we have no EOCs that our students will take and no Juniors to take the ACT. For Math III we held a composite of 81.3%.

Our graduation rate was 100% for the 2020-21 graduation class and we hope to maintain it with the 25 seniors this year.

The program is in a rebuilding phase, as after this class the school must be reestablished. The staff is intentional on providing social emotional support, rigorous course instruction, intervention and enrichment and opportunities for experiential learning.

The school has support staff that is inclusive of the Principal, Curriculum Facilitator, College Liaison, Social Worker, Counselor and Data Manager/Treasurer.
