# Guidelines for National Technical Honor Society Chapter At Southeast Guilford High School

## **Student Nominations & Application Process**

Students will be inducted into the Southeast Guilford High Chapter of the National Technical Honor Society by nomination only by a Career & Technical Education Teacher; after which a membership application must be completed an submitted to the NTHS advisor or its designee. The students will need to obtain an additional recommendation from another member of the faculty. The requirements for membership are listed below. CTE Teacher Nominations are due <u>TBA</u>.

## **Career and Technical Education Requirements:**

The Southeast High School National Technical Honor Society is open to all juniors and seniors who have a current <u>unweighted</u> 3.5 overall GPA that meet all Guilford County Schools requirement criteria. <u>Each</u> <u>candidate must have completed or be enrolled in a completer track program as defined by GCS</u>. The application process includes evaluation of leadership, character, and service to school and community.

# **Academic and Non-Academic Requirements:**

NTHS members must maintain an overall GPA of 3.5 and maintain a Career and Technical Education GPA of 3.5 to remain an active member here at Southeast HS. The student cannot have any current discipline or attendance problems.

#### **Chapter and Community Service Requirements:**

All NTHS members are expected to be active in the society. NTHS members are also expected to be active in community service. NTHS will accept community service hours from any Career and Technical Service Organization (CTSO) Service Project (outside school hours). In addition, NTHS will have community service projects with a focus on promoting Career and Technical Education.

# **Graduation Honor Requirements**

Members must have attended three of every four general meetings to remain active in the chapter.

Members that have accumulated a total of 100 hours of community service will be eligible to purchase and wear a graduation cord during the High school graduation commencement exercise.
