Choir students will perform appropriate literature to further develop their maturing voices, musicality and proficiency in music literacy (rhythm and tonal) skills. Students will perform at concerts throughout the year and have the opportunity to participate in other events such as music festivals, All County Chorus, and Honors Chorus.

Classroom Procedures and Expectations

Students must have their binder at the beginning of each rehearsal and will put their folder back into their assigned spot at the end of each rehearsal.

- Be prepared have all your materials and a positive attitude
- Be respectful respect your peers, classroom, and the teacher

Concert Policy

All chorus students are required to perform in 2 concerts a year, including one in December and one in May. In addition to performing, all students must wear the appropriate concert attire as described – chorus polo shirt (or solid royal blue polo shirt) tucked into black dress pants w/black shoes. Students not adhering to the chorus dress code will not be permitted to perform. **Failure to participate in a concert results in a zero for a test grade**. Concerts missed due to a family emergency or serious illness may be made-up.

Concert Attire

All students are expected to wear our formal concert attire in all performances to maintain a professional appearance. No child will be turned away from singing in choir because of inability to purchase an outfit. If you need assistance, please contact me.

- Singers wear short sleeved royal blue polo shirt. **Order form is attached**.
- ALL singers wear solid BLACK pants.
- ALL singers wear BLACK shoes.

If you are a returning chorus student, please double check to make sure that your polo is in good condition with no holes or tears and that it still fits. If you are planning to order a new polo, please donate the previous polo to the program.
