Brief description of class: Upon completion of the Carpentry classes, students will have mastered the orientation of the trade, know about the materials, fasteners, and adhesives used, will know how to use the power and hand tools safely, understand construction drawings/plans, and understand floor, wall, ceiling systems and basic stair layout. Students will also gain knowledge in commercial drawings, metal studs and exterior finishing. Students will also look into roofing applications, door hardware, drywall installation and finishing. Students will be in the lab working on projects throughout the semester.

Course Goals: We will be following the NC Course Blueprint.

Textbooks: We will be using two different textbooks this year. Both textbooks will be from the Contren Learning Series, one will be the Core textbook and the other will be the Green Environment textbook.

While we explore these books, students will be tested during each chapter. There are a couple of reasons behind these tests. One is for certification. If the student passes a test with a "75", that student will be entered into the NCCER certification where, at the end of the year, they will receive a card showing their name and certification area. NCCER stands for National Center for Construction Education and Research. Again, this is a National certification and will go everywhere with the student. The Other reason for the tests is to see how the student is gaining the material, what the student is understanding, so we can back up a little if need be. These chapter tests get the students ready for the CTE/EOC test.

Breakdown of grading percentages:

Students are not allowed to miss more than three days.
