Attendances/Tardies:

Attendance will be taken daily. A student is considered tardy if they are not in the <u>classroom</u> when the bell rings at 7:25. Please be sure to send a note for all absences. If you know of an absence in advance, please let us know so we can prepare work for your child to prevent falling behind. Vacations require a note to be approved by the principal in advance. Majority of our instruction will happen between 7:30-11:30am. Please try to protect this time.

Homework:

- Reading Read 30 minutes nightly
- Math Nightly lesson practice
- Unfinished classwork
- Other as assigned by teachers. Check CANVAS/planner.

Homework grades are based on completion. 100% for complete and on time (must try all questions), 50% for late or incomplete, 0% missing (after 3 days)..

Missing/Late Assignments:

A late assignment includes:

- 1. Incomplete assignment.
- 2. Leaving assignments/supplies at home.
- 3. Not taking home needed materials to complete an assignment

Late assignments will receive <u>half</u> credit unless otherwise noted in the assignment.

An assignment is considered *missing* if not turned in within 3 days of the expected due date and will receive a <u>zero</u>.

Communication:

Students can communicate questions with teachers using their Canvas inbox.
