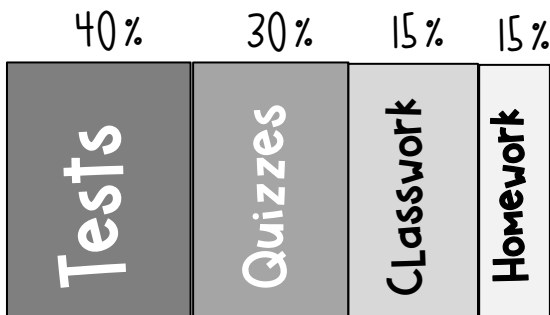
Absent Work

If you are **absent**, you are responsible for finding your missed work in the absent work bin on the counter. You have 3 school days to complete all your missing work and show it to the teacher. If work is submitted after the 3-day time frame, the highest grade possible will be 70% for the assignment. You need to put notes into your interactive notebook. Use notes and help videos on Canvas to help you make up work.

Late Work

When assigned, ALL canvas assignments are open for 3 days past the original due date. There will be a late penalty applied to any assignments; therefore, work should be turned in on its due date. Late work will lose points on a per-day-late basis. Missing assignments (after the unit test) will result in a zero for the assignment.

If you are absent on a review day or test/quiz, day you are expected to take the assessment the next day you are in class.

If an assignment was assigned in advance of your absence and due the day you come back from being absent, the **assignment is due that day**.
