Course Description:

This is a college level course. It follows the Advanced Placement Calculus AB syllabus, which can be found at apcentral.collegeboard.org The primary goal of this course is to develop students' understanding of calculus, provide opportunities to apply its techniques, and prepare students for a second semester college calculus course or AP Calculus BC.

You will have three days after your return to school to submit any and all work you missed during your absence.

Homework:

Homework will be assigned regularly. It is expected that students in an AP course will spend about 4-5 hours on homework each week.

Quizzes/Tests:

Quizzes and tests will be administered regularly. All tests will be announced in advance but not all quizzes will be planned. It is your responsibility to be ready for a quiz at any time.
