We wanted to let you know that End-of-Course (EOC) test scores are being communicated directly to each student. Every student will receive an individual message via GCS email or Canvas inbox with their performance details and any necessary next steps.

For students who scored Not Proficient (NP) on the EOC test, they will have the opportunity to retake the test at the end of the school year. More information regarding the retake process will be shared in the coming weeks. In the meantime, students are encouraged to participate in learning hubs and enrichment sessions to strengthen their understanding of the material.

For students who scored at Levels 3, 4, and 5, we are thrilled to celebrate their accomplishments and achievements in passing the EOC test. These scores indicate that students have demonstrated proficiency or higher in the subject. While we commend their hard work, we remain committed to providing additional support as needed to help all students continue excelling and reaching their goals.

We encourage students to review their EOC performance information carefully and share it with their parents. By discussing the results together, parents and students can better understand the skills that have been mastered and those that need further improvement. It is important to note that these skills will be assessed again in college preparatory exams such as the PSAT, ACT, and SAT. Strong performance on these exams not only reflects academic readiness but can also help students qualify for valuable scholarships for college.
