Eat healthy


Get plenty of exercise



LOCKER TIPS

- Never share your locker
- **Never** preset your lock



■ **Don't panic** if you forgot your locker number or combination. Your homeroom teacher has a master list and can assist you if needed.





Step 1: Clear the lock by spinning the dial clockwise a few times

Step 2: Still turning clockwise stop the dial on the first number




Step 3: Now spin the dial counter-clockwise and stop the dial on the second number.

IMPORTANT NOTE: make sure to pass the second number <u>once</u> before stopping at it the 2nd time.



Step 4: Now spin the dial clock wise again stopping on the 3rd number.



Step 5: Pull up on the lock!
