Classroom News

ELA/Social Studies: (English Language Arts) We are starting a new unit on non-fiction texts. Our focus will be about plants. We will learn about plants by listening to a variety of non-fiction texts. The students will have an opportunity to compare different types of plants, as well as learning about the life cycle of different plants.

Math: We began a new module on shapes! This week we are finding and describing 2D shapes using informal language. For example, I may describe a 2D shape by having 5 corners and 5 straight sides that are all equal. We will also start sorting 2D shapes by curves and straight sides and corners. Today the Boys and girls were shape detectives! They had a great time walking around the classroom drawing and describing the different 2D shapes they found with a partner.

Skills: We are continuing to practice segmenting words and blending words. This week we are learning a special vowel, the /e/ sound. We are also practicing reading and writing one-syllable short vowel Consonant Vowel Consonant words.
