

The music pro students learn how to construct their own music using different types of technology. They also learn about music theory and musicianship.

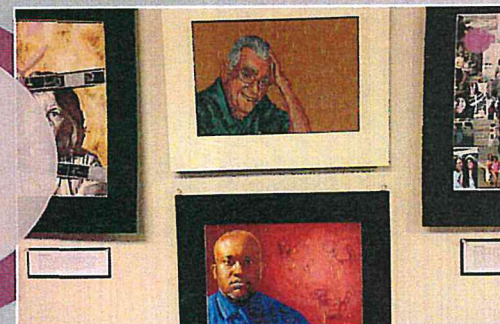
Theater
