Expectations

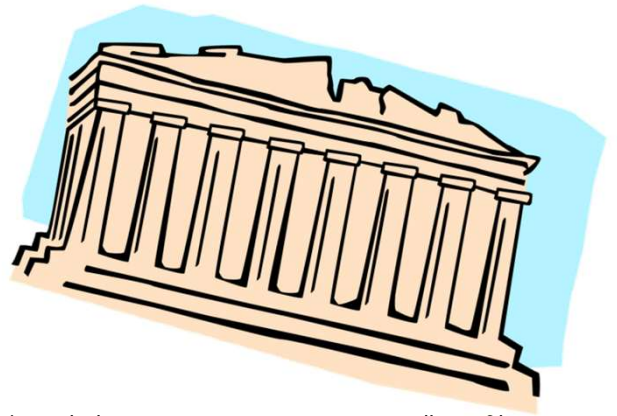
- ➔ Participate daily in class activities and discussions.
