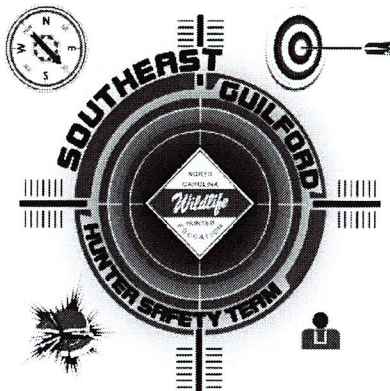


SOUTHEAST GUILFORD FFA HUNTER SAFETY TEAM



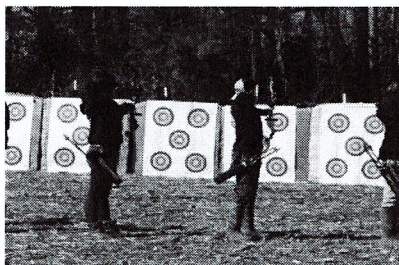
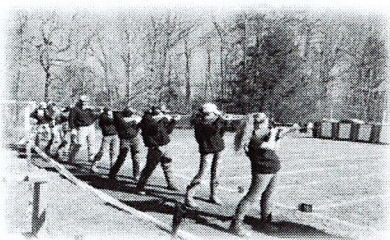
The Southeast Guilford FFA Hunter Safety Team is compiled of students from SE High School and SE Middle School who have an interest in promoting the safe sport of hunting and shooting. The team practices for competition in 4 events - shotgun, .22 rifle, archery and hunter skills/orienteering at our team range located at 6308 Company Mill Rd.

Competition teams are composed of 5 players in 4 events to create 20 positions. The number of competition teams depends on number of eligible team members in each event.

Firearm safety along with hunter safety skills are the most important characteristics of the Hunter Safety Team. Along with practicing firearm safety, you will learn to identify game animals, know how to hunt them and hunt safely. Hunter safety also teaches survival skills, first aid and wildlife conservation. All team members are **required** to take written tests on hunter safety skills. Material for these tests comes from *Today's Hunter* certification course book.

Requirements :

- Have a Hunter Education Certification number OR complete a Hunter Ed Cert. course by November. If Hunter Ed Certification course is needed, contact Brian Newell 336-327-1948 to get registered.
- Attend practices each Saturday beginning Sept/Oct until end of April.
- Sign and return all required forms along with one-time range fee.
- Shooting equipment, as well as eye / ear protection are required.
(shotgun, .22 rifle, bow & 6 arrows with practice tips only depending on which event(s) you are wanting to participate in. **NO AMMUNITION OR BROADHEADS ARE TO BE BROUGHT ONTO RANGE!**
We provide ammunition. We have team equipment and eye/ear protection, if you don't have your own).
- Be a member of SEHS or SEMS FFA by November.
