### What is it?

American Legion Auxiliary (ALA) Tar Heel Girls State is an Americanism project designed to provide rising high school senior girls an opportunity to study citizenship in a democracy with a "hands-on" approach. The program's goal is to develop a sense of the responsibilities of citizenship within young women leaders. The week is a practical study of the structure and operation of North Carolina state government.

# Who is the Program's Sponsor?

## What would I do during the week?

- Participants, we call them citizens, will be grouped in cities to organize their own local government, electing officers, preparing a city charter and conducting city activities.
- Citizens will research and write bills and resolutions for the Girls State legislature.
- Citizens will be a member of a fictitious political party which will develop a party platform, engineer campaigns for party candidates and finally elect a slate of officers to govern Tar Heel Girls State.
- Tar Heel Girls State will host top state officials and outstanding speakers from a variety of fields.

# What are the eligibility requirements?

- Must be a junior in high school at the time of selection.
- Between the ages of 16 and 18 years old.
- Ranked in the top 1/3 of her class or have an unweighted GPA of 3.0.
- Resident of NC for 1 year prior to selection and be currently attending a NC high school.
- Must be a U.S. Citizen or legal resident of the U.S.
