He worked in higher education, nonprofit management, and consulting.

he was elected the first African American Chairman of the Guilford County Republican

Party and ran a strong campaign for a seat on the Guilford County Board of Commissioners in 2020. Troy also worked tirelessly on several local and statewide political campaigns. He had a passion for education and was a proud member of the board at Gate City Charter Academy in Greensboro, NC.

In his free time, Troy enjoyed spending time with his wife, daughters, and dogs Oscar, Winnie, and Kramer, watching his favorite shows Seinfeld and The Office, and creating new recipes in the kitchen. He was also an official Kansas City BBQ Judge. He and his wife loved trying new restaurants and spending summers at Carolina Beach, NC. One of his proudest accomplishments was reaching the rank of Eagle Scout in The Boy Scouts of America in 1979. Troy Lawson passed away during heart surgery on November 30th, 2020.

- US Citizen, registered to vote in Guilford County, NC
- Demonstrates service in the local community during high school: Examples: Teen Age Republicans (TARS), scouting, political campaigns, mission work, church, educational volunteer opportunities, or local volunteering in other non-profit organizations. Registered to Vote

Interested Guilford County high school seniors are to apply and mail the following application hardcopy documents by the due date of May 1:

- 1. An essay that contains the following: (one-page minimum and three-page maximum, double spaced, font size 10-12.)
 - What do you love about America? (paragraph response in the essay)
 - What are your core conservative values and how do you demonstrate those values in your life as a teen? (paragraph response in the essay)
- 2. Official high school transcript (properly sealed in an envelope)
- 3. Current resume (include education, achievements, part-time work, volunteer service)
- 4. Copy of a government-issued photo ID (driver's permit or driver's license (front/back) or US passport.)
- 5. Two letters of recommendation from educators, coaches, club advisers, religious leaders, volunteer organizations, and/or employers. (no family or friends)
- 6. Letter of acceptance from your chosen technical/trade school, community college, or a four-year university for upcoming fall semester.
