General Information

Description

This class is designed to help you improve your ability to read and write the English Language. Your goal is to refine your skills in reading comprehension and composition, as well as, your control and correct use of grammar. We will focus on helping you to enhance the four skills of the language: Reading, writing, listening, and speaking, so you can get a better performance in your core classes.

Required materials

For this class you need to bring a Lined paper notebook, which will be used in class for note taking, complete assignments, and grammar.

You also need to bring your own materials to class, such as, pencils, highlighters, red pen, eraser, color pencils, markers etc.

Class content

You will be working on different topics during the semester, which will help you gain a better domain of the language, further developing grammar, sentence patterns, vocabulary and literature. Researched projects and presentations are also included in this semester.

We will also be focusing on learning different strategies that facilitates your understanding of the passages and readings during the semester. We will use our Pathway to Success approach and other strategies such as making inference, main idea, and juicy sentence.

In grammar, we will aboard some parts of the speech (review nouns, and regular/irregular verbs), adjectives, adverbs, etc.

Class Rules and procedures

- Arrive on time to class before the bell rings. If you are late, you should bring a note from a teacher/administrator to excuse the tardy.

First tardy = verbal warning ; Second tardy = parent contact; Third tardy= parent contact, student detained 1 minute after class; fourth tardy= parent contact, student detained 1 minute after class; fifth tardy= parent contact, student detained 1 minute after class, administrative referral for after school detention; sixth tardy= parent contact, student detained 1 minute after class, administrative referral for after school detention; seventh tardy= administrative referral for additional consequences
