



Math I Syllabus
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Course Description: This course will emphasize skills necessary for problem-solving and continued growth in mathematics. Students will apply concepts, communicate, reason, create models and make connections in the following areas:

- Module 1: Sequences
- Module 2: Linear & Exponential Functions
- Module 3: Features of Functions
- Module 4: Equations & Inequalities
- Module 5: Systems of Equations & Inequalities
- Module 6: Quadratic Functions
- Module 7: Structures of Quadratic Functions
- Module 8: Connecting Algebra & Geometry
- Module 9: Modeling Data

Course Requirements: Students are required to keep a three-ring binder with all notes, handouts, activities, classroom assignments, and homework assignments.

Materials List: Three-ring binder, notebook, paper, pencils, pens, high lighters, tab dividers folder.

Wish List: Tissues, extra pencils, dry erase markers, hand sanitizer.

Classroom Resources: Math Textbooks, MVP Spiral Books

Grading Expectations: Homework is checked using grading rubrics. To receive full credit, homework must be turned in on the day it is due. Homework not completed on the day it is due will result in an incomplete until finished. Students may turn in homework late but at the cost of a lower grade on the assignment. Late work will not be accepted after the unit test has been given. It is the student's responsibility to know the time frame for turning in work for the course.
