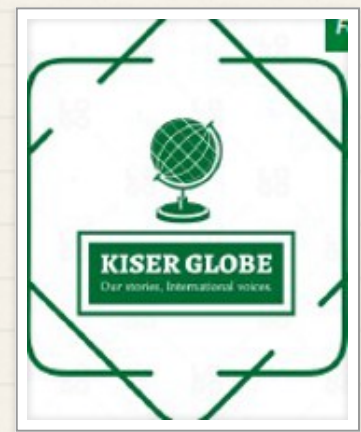

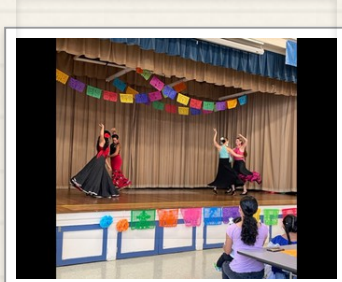


Diwali Celebration at Colfax Elementary.

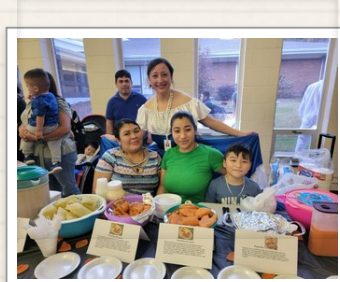

We're wrapping up Hispanic Heritage Month by showcasing some of the activities all around our GCS schools. Thank you for sharing these moments with us!



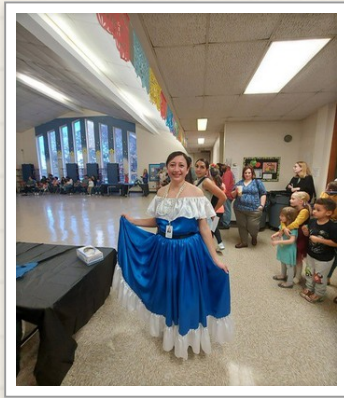

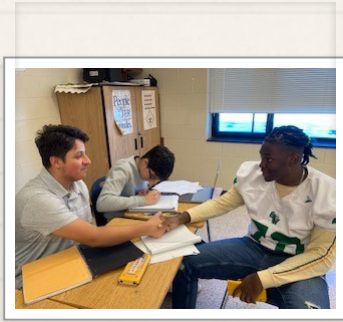


DID YOU KNOW... ?

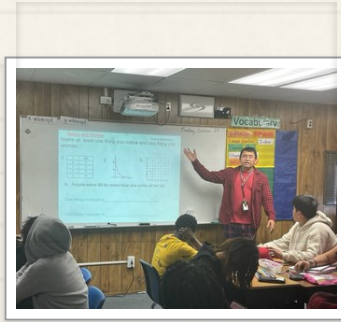

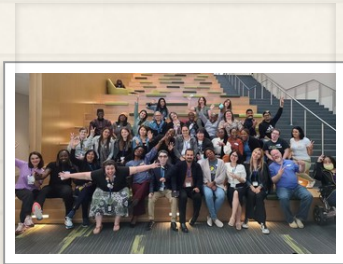

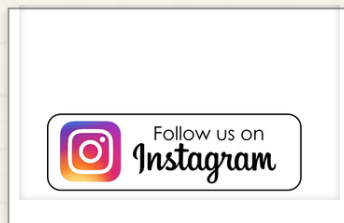
