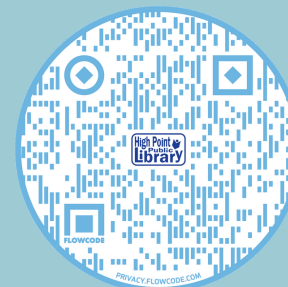

GOALS (Guilford's Open Access to Libraries for Students), is rooted in the shared belief that through improved and equal access to information, reading, technology and a stronger community, students will be better positioned for lifelong learning and sustained success – our number one goal.

Through the GOALS partnership, students enrolled in GCS can access library research databases, borrow digital materials such as e-books, e-audiobooks, magazines, music, and videos using just their GCS student ID number.

Through GOALS students now have access to Read Squared our online reading and logging program.

Your Reading

Students can choose from a variety of customizable avatars to represent them in the online reading program. Students earn points by reading. For every minute a student reads they earn one point; at 100 points they reach a new level. There are 10 levels in the program. With each level students unlock, they earn badges, missions, games, and a chance to win prizes. Students also earn a certificate for program completion.



Library Media Specialists and teachers that implement this program at their school will have access to the control room which allows them to confirm reading logs, read students' book reviews, missions, and events. Read Squared is a wonderful tool for every classroom.

READING LISTS

Read Squared also has reading lists which are grade level appropriate for ages 5-7, 7-9, 9-12, and the Battle of the Books list for elementary and middle schools.
