Guilford County Schools is committed to preparing its students to be physically active and healthy for a lifetime. The General Assembly of North Carolina has enacted House Bill 1757 that <u>requires</u> all students in grades K-8 to complete a health-enhancing personal fitness assessment.

Students in grades $\underline{K-8}$ will complete the FITNESSGRAM® assessment in the fall and spring. The FITNESSGRAM® is composed of 5 components: Aerobic Capacity, Body Composition, Muscular Strength, Muscular Endurance, and Flexibility.

The Body Composition test requires that students have their height and weight recorded. Please note that the height/weight measurements are collected privately and are kept confidential. If you do NOT want your child involved in the Body Composition portion of the test, then you must contact your child's **PE teacher**, **Ms. Pagano**.
