There are opportunities throughout the year for your son/daughter to participate in numerous NJROTC activities. The opportunity to learn, develop, and practice leadership skills essential to future success is one of our primary goals. The cadets occupy staff and team leadership roles to accomplish this. We are also heavily involved Community Service/projects, STEM activities (Sea Perch and Drone,) trips to compete against rival schools in Drill, Academics, Physical Fitness (PT) and Marksmanship. We also participate in both school and public activities such as Color Guard for events such as graduations, sporting events, and military honors. We also actively engage in various parades, veterans appreciation/support and advanced leadership training for those who have earned the opportunity.

Uniforms are issued and required to be worn (1) time per week. These uniforms are at no expense to the parents or cadets unless they are lost or damaged by neglect. We will also issue, free of charge athletic wear for cadets to wear for PT. They are provided to each cadet and are theirs to keep.

Another positive aspect for rising 9<sup>th</sup> graders is the daily interaction with upper classmen. Our cadets make sure that all cadets are welcome and are immediately added to the team. NJROTC is a safe haven for all grades to interact with each other. It is encouraged, mandated, and part of our daily routine.
