The Early College at Guilford 2022-2023 Student Fees

Each student is issued a Quaker Card with a unique Banner G#. These are essential tools for navigating Guilford's systems: the Quaker Card serves as the student's photo ID on campus, and the G# serves as the student's account number. Students can also load funds onto their Quaker Card and use it like a debit card on campus. Early College students must carry their Guilford College Quaker Card on them at all times. The Quaker card also serves as the "key" to most of the campus buildings.

Below is a list of current fees, both required and optional. The College will mail invoices home in early August. In addition, students can check their accounts online through Touch Net. Please note that failure to pay fees will result in a "hold" on the student's account. As long as a hold is in place, the student will not be able to register for classes. It takes one business day to clear a hold.

REQUIRED:

<u>Library Resources Fee</u>: \$35.00. This is an annual Guilford College fee for <u>ALL ECG students</u>, <u>9th-12th grades</u>. It covers the direct cost of digital library resources, including indexing and abstracting services as well as full-text content of periodicals, reference works, image banks, and statistical data sets.

OPTIONAL EXPENSES:

Meals: Students can eat in The Grill or the college cafeteria. Lunch is \$10.00 plus tax for ECG students.

<u>Copy/Printing</u>: Students can photocopy and print on any public printer on campus. By tapping their Quaker Card on a printer/copier, they can access their printing/copying allocation and release print jobs from a central server. Black and white copies are \$0.07/page; color copies are \$0.15/page.

Private Music Lessons: Students take private music lessons for a number of instruments: piano, guitar, violin, flute, clarinet, etc. Fees are \$350 (30 minutes/week, 1 credit hour) and \$700 (1 hr/week, 2 credit hours). To explore private lessons:

<u>Motor Vehicle Registration/Parking Sticker:</u> Students who park on campus must register their vehicle with Public Safety in the basement of Bauman. Once at Public Safety, they need to provide their vehicle's year, make, model, color, and license plate number. <u>There is no cost to register a vehicle on campus effective Fall 2020.</u> *NOTE: Parking FINES for unregistered vehicles are \$100 per incident.*

<u>Bicycle Registration/Decal:</u> Free but required. Registration is required for bicycles on campus, including bicycles belonging to Early College students. Students will need to provide the bike serial number to Public Safety.

Replacement Quaker Card: \$15 if old is returned; \$25 if old is lost. Your first Quaker Card is FREE! Students who lose or damage their Quaker Card must pay to replace it. Replacement cards are issued at the IT&S Help Desk in Bauman during the academic year.

HOW TO PAY:

By cash or check:

- 1. Mail a check, <u>payable to **Guilford College**</u>. Be sure to note the student's name and G# on the memo line. Mail to Guilford College | ATTN: Student Accounts | P.O. Box 18743 | Greensboro, NC 27419-8743.
- 2. Go in person to the office of the Registrar and Student Accounts in the basement of New Garden Hall. Students will need to show their Quaker Card or provide their G#.

NOTE: New Garden WILL have staff available to receive checks, however, if at all possible, please mail your check or pay online to reduce interactions with college staff.

By credit card or electronic check:

- 1. Login to the online, 24/7, accounts system, Touch Net: https://secure.touchnet.net/C20821_tsa/web/login.jsp
- 2. Log in with G# and Banner PIN. (Entering students will set up their Banner PIN the second week of class.)

Touch Net allows parents to create a separate UserID linked to the student's account. Follow the directions at the Web address above.
