2025 Scholarship Guidelines and Application

The Metropolitan Greensboro Area Section was organized in 1946 as a Section of the National Council of Negro Women (NCNW). Our mission is to lead, develop and advocate for women of African descent as they support their families and communities. Our programs are grounded on a foundation of critical concerns for the promotion of education; health care and access; and social justice.

A primary focus of the Section is to encourage young females of African descent to achieve excellence by seeking higher education. The Section will help to reduce the financial barrier to a college degree by providing a \$500.00 scholarship to a 2025 graduating senior.

Who May Apply

- A female student of African decent
- A 2025 graduating high school senior.
- A female student registered in a Guilford County School
- A female resident of Guilford County

Eligibility Criteria

- Provide an official transcript that shows a minimum of 2.5/4.0 grade point average.
- Must provide evidence in writing of scholastic achievement, leadership abilities, and community services
- Provide evidence of acceptance to an accredited college/university
- Plan to attend an accredited college or university or a certificate granting education program for the 2025 Fall Semester
- Provide two (2) type written letters of recommendation; one from a school official and one from a community representative regarding community service activities
- Provide an essay with 300-500 words describing involvement in school activities, leadership positions in organizations, honors, awards, special recognition, community service activities in church, girl scouts, social activities, volunteer, and job experiences.

How To Apply

Submit a completed application (by email or regular mail) by April 1, 2025. Handwritten applications will not be accepted.

REMEMBER TO INCLUDE:

- Write an essay with 300-500 words based on your school activities and community service engagement (church, organizations, volunteer, and job experiences). Include your name on each page of the application.
- Request your school send an official copy of your transcript, with an official stamp or seal to, Metropolitan Area Section-NCNW, P.O. Box 39144, Greensboro, NC 27438.
- Request letters of recommendation- one from the school and one from a community service organization.
- Attach a copy of your letter of acceptance from a college/university (if available), with your application.

<u>APRIL 1, 2025, is the deadline</u> for receiving completed application and supporting documentations. Send all documents to:
