Application and references must be received by ***Saturday, May 24, 2025***. The Scholarship Committee will notify the finalist by Friday, June 15, 2025.

I. Eligibility requirement for applicants

- A. Application submitted to college or university in North Carolina
- B. Academic rank in top 20% of class
- C. Minimum SAT score of 1100 (combining math and reading) (If chosen College/University requires them)
- D. Good character
- E. Participation in extra-curricular activities (school and community)
- F. Financial aid (important factor)
- G. Major in the field of education

II. Data to be submitted

- A. Application
- B. Transcript (including first semester senior grades, SAT and / or ACT scores, if required by the College/University chosen, cumulative numerical academic average, and rank in class)
- C. Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a teacher. (Include character traits, special talents and abilities, examples of leadership and service, etc.)
- D. Recent picture
- E. Letter from applicant stating her plans, career goals, and reasons for wanting this scholarship.
