To use Beanstack on a personal phone or tablet, download the Beanstack app. Once you're in the app, choose "At my library, school, or bookstore," and then search for your school. Sign in via Clever and start logging!

MINUTES DUE IN BEANSTACK BY APRIL 5!

Students who cannot record their minutes over spring break can enter them in Beanstack when they return to school in April. To count toward the challenge, minutes will need to be dated during Spring Break. See your school library media coordinator for assistance logging minutes correctly!
