Western Guilford High School Senior Reserved Painted Parking Spaces

Who?: Seniors Only and Staff

Why?: To beautify the campus! To build school spirit!

To create a senior tradition!

To raise money for the Western PTSO, so that this organization can continue to support **all** Students, Staff, and Parents

Cost: \$15- Does not include school parking permit which will be \$50 as mandated by Guilford County Schools.

Does not include supplies: paint, paint brushes, etc

The Process:

*Please note that the allotted parking spaces are sold on a first come first serve basis **August 4th, 5th and 6th from 9:00- 11:00 and 1-3 in the front hallway.** There will be a designated area for the painted spaces. Parking spaces will be sold in the Guidance Office after the 6th.

- **Step 1:** Pick up a packet in the school main office or download it from the WGHS Homepage starting in July. We'll notify you when it is ready.
- Step 2: Return the packet to the Main office by July 29th.
- What you will need in order to purchase your Painted Parking Space:
- 1. A check or cash for \$50.00. Make checks payable to Western Guilford HS.
- 2. A second check made out to Western Guilford PTSO for \$15.00. Cash is fine also. Debit or credit card will also be accepted for the \$15.00 portion.
- 3. The completed School Application for your parking permit (included).
- **4.** A signed copy of the Reserved Painted Parking Space Contract (included).
- **5.** A copy of the design for your parking space. This must be attached and completed on the design form (included).

Your design should be clearly drawn on this form and must include the colors you will be using in your parking space. **No changes can be made on painting day.**

6. We will keep a copy of your drawing, so **make a copy for yourself**.

*Once your design has been reviewed, you will receive an email or call <u>ONLY</u> if your design is <u>unacceptable</u>, or if any changes need to be made

Painting Requirements

- Paint must be water based interior/exterior latex.
- **Do not** cover the white lines, front curb/bumper block, or number of the parking space. Students must leave 4 inches between the white lines and the design. It is advisable to tape this border off prior to painting. It takes about 2 gallons if you want to do a base coat, before painting your design. Old paint works really well also.
- No spray, fluorescent, reflective, glitter, oil based, or other types of paint allowed
- No offensive language, pictures, flags, or symbols.
- No negative or rude language.
- No symbols related to gang-activity or gang-style tagging.
- No double meanings, nicknames, girlfriend/boyfriend names, etc. Only your own name will be allowed.
- No use of names belonging to other students.

Prohibited items will be painted over at the discretion of the Administration and you will forfeit your right to a parking space. Your money will not be refunded.

Painting days will be August 10th, 11th, 12th, and 15th from 8:30- 4:00. We suggest that the you start painting early, because it gets hot in the afternoon. We may have a second round of painting November 30th- December 5th for those just getting their license and want to paint, if there is an interest. If you will be out of town during the painting days, please contact me at sppa-pier@gmail.com

On Painting Day, check in at the PTSO car in the parking lot starting at 8:30 AM.

You will need:

- 1. Your copy of your design.
- 2. A receipt showing that you have paid for the Regular Parking Permit and Painting Privileges, and your spot number.
- **3.** A form of ID
- **4.** Newspaper, tarp, tape, or something to block off the rest of the parking space so paint will not get on anything other than your designated space.
- **5.** A broom to sweep your space before you begin painting.
- **6.** Paint brushes, paint, painter's tape, a bucket of water, or any other supplies that you might need. Wear sunscreen and bring water.

Spaces will be the student's personal parking space until the end of the year at which time you will paint over your space. Black paint will be provided by the school. Spaces must be painted over prior to graduation or incur a \$15 fine. The seniors will chose two of their favorite spots, and they will stay that way an additional year.

(This is all subject to modification depending on the start of school)

Suggested Materials, Tips, and Hints

Check in upon arrival with approved design form, receipts of payment, space number

Water based primer paint/base coat if desired- It takes about 2 gallons for a base coat Paint can be expensive, so ask family members and friends if they have extra paint to donate. Consider limiting the number of colors in your design. Share paint with friends.

Chalk to sketch your design first

Paint brushes and/or paint rollers- try to use a roller with extension handle for the base coat.

Paint roller extension

Paint pans or plastic containers for water, brushes, and paint and wooden stirrers

Blue painter's tape, 4 inches wide to mark off spot

Plastic drop cloth to put under paint cans (remember paint can't be erased)

Broom to sweep spot

Old cloths or paper towels

A bag for your trash

Sunshade, sunscreen, umbrellas, sunglasses, hats, pop up canopy to block sun

Water, snacks

Lawn chairs, stool, towels to sit on
