Salary

\$45,000-\$60,000_per year

Education/Training

Medical (Biomedical) Lab Technicians must complete an accredited Medical Laboratory Technician program, obtain an associate degree in Medical Technology, and pass the certification examination. While participating in a Medical Laboratory Technician program, you will become proficient in a variety of sciences and learn how to perform laboratory procedures involving Hematology, Genealogy, Chemistry, and Microbiology.
