

How do I register a student?

Complete the online
SchoolMint Application, come
to our school to fill out the
paperwork, and please bring
a copy of the child's birth
certificate and proof of
address.

How long will my student be at SMNS?

Students remain at SMNS for one (1) year, at the end of one full year, the student gets transitioned to their zone school which is determined by their address.

What if my student is absent?

Please send a doctor's note or a handwritten note stating the date, student name, and reason along with the parent's name and signature. This can be given to Mr. Cortez at the front office.

When does my student get a bus?

GCS Department of Transportation takes about 5-10 business days to send our school new student bus information.
