What are we learning?

ELA: Ask and answer questions about key details to a text.

Math: Count numbers 0-5, write numbers 1-5, count to tell the number of objects -5, and write numbers 1-5.

Science: I can describe a community.

Writing: I can write my name with the first initial capitalized.

Students should use a #2 PENCIL to write their names and trace their letters or numbers unless it is otherwise specified. Please do NOT allow them to write using a pen, crayon, or marker.

Homework for the week of September 28th

Monday:

Wednesday:
