Goal I: By 2022, the percentage of students who will read proficiently by the end of third grade will increase to 63%.

Goal IV: By 2022, increase by 50 percent the number of schools that exceed growth (currently 32.5 percent).

Goal V: By 2022, decrease the achievement gap between black and Latino students and their white peers by 7 percentage points.
