

# ...RETURN ACCESS MATERIALS ←



Our ACCESS testing window closes on Friday, 3/10.

The attached documents contain detailed instructions on how to pack your materials **prior to bringing them to the EL office.** 

#### Important reminders:

- 1. Continue to run the "Expect ACCESS Test" report in PS and cross check it with the WIDA AMS roster to confirm that everyone has been tested.
- 1. Go into the Test Management>Manage Test Sessions dropdown in AMS to confirm that the Status column shows Completed for all testing sessions.
- If any of your test sessions are showing "In Progress" and you are certain everyone in the session was tested, check the "Edit/Print Ticket Status" under Show Sessions. This most likely is showing In Progress because one or more students did not exit all the way to the end of the test.


