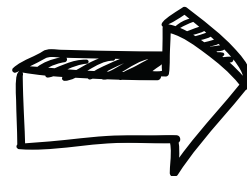

*MS. JOHNSON'S *RECCOMENDATIONS*

I recommend getting items from Amazon, Moore Music, or Music and Arts.

- **Rosin:** Violins/violas need light rosin and cellos/basses need dark rosin. D'Addario is a great brand.
- **Instrument:** I do NOT recommend Amazon instruments. Please seek out rental/purchase opportunities with Moore Music or Music and Arts.
- **Shoulder rest:** NANYI brand on Amazon is about \$8 and works great. KUN brand is good as well.
- **Endpin stop:** 'The Original Slipstop Endpin Rest for Cello' is one of the few that won't slip. I also recommend Xeros Endpin Anchor. I do NOT recommend the stops with a golden inside circle.
- **Clip on Tuner:** 'D'Addario Equinox' and any Snark tuner are the best.
- **Cleaning cloth:** Microfiber cleaning cloth specifically for instruments can be found for less than \$6 on Amazon.
- **Extra strings:** Buy one set of replacement strings for the instrument. 'D'Addario Prelude' are my recommendation.
- **Method book:** Make sure you're getting the right book for your grade and instrument ~\$10 on Amazon or local music store.
