What is middle school registration?

- The process of requesting courses
- Registration = Course Requests (not guaranteed)
- Register for your zoned school or confirmed choice school
- The Middle school will create schedules over the summer

Zoned Middle School

- Based on the street address in PowerSchool
- Choose courses for the school that shows up in your registration window
- Update your address now if you've moved
 - Proof of address to data manager

What if I've applied somewhere else?

- Register your child for their zoned school even if:
 - GCS Choice school waiting list
 - Applying for Reassignment in May
 - Charter or private school
 - Moving out of GCS district

Where are we in the registration process?

- Counselor visit 5th grade classrooms last week
- Counselors visit from Kiser Thursday 2/13
- Registration information has been posted on GG's School
 Counseling web page if available
- Registration books are available online

Parent Registration Window

- Parent Online Registration window: February 14 February 23
- Opens at 5 p.m.
- One student's request doesn't take precedence over another

Parent's Role

- We encourage you to register during the parent window (2/14-2/23)
- Talk with your child about course preferences
- Log into PowerSchool Student with child to make course requests
- Requests are not guaranteed

Registration Process at School

- After students have completed their initial selections, they will work with the counselor to ensure the selections are appropriate and that they are on a path to achieve their long-term goals
- Parents can view course selections made in PowerSchool Parent portal
- Counselor will print a copy and send home in March

What are Encore Classes?

- Like the "specials" of middle school
- All students take PE/Health
- GCS Choice Schools sometimes offer specialized encores

Encores continued

- Select 4 Encores
- PE/Health counts as 1
- If you choose an Everyday Encore (Band, Orchestra or Everyday Chorus),
 choose 1 additional Encore.
- If you do not choose an Everyday Encore, you will choose 3 additional
- Choose alternates if requested

Global Languages

- Check with your middle school for language offerings
- 6th grade is the introductory course
- 7th and 8th grade can then be taken for 1 high school credit (if passing grade)

Career & Technical Education (CTE) Encores

- Taking CTE courses in middle school allows students to explore a variety of industry areas to help determine potential careers.
- High School CTE Pathway can provide them with an opportunity to earn industry-recognized credentials and community college credit and participate in a work-based learning experience (apprenticeship, cooperative education, job shadow, or internship)
- 57 CTE pathways in H.S.

Arts Education Graduation Requirement

- Includes: music, visual art, theatre arts, dance, etc.
- One credit of Arts Education required for H.S. Graduation
- Students can complete this at any time during grades 6-12
- Middle school arts courses count as a half credit
- Reminder: must start band or orchestra in 6th grade

Core Classes

 All students will take Math, English/Language Arts, Science and Social Studies

English Language Arts (ELA)

- Language Arts 6
- Advanced Language Arts 6
 - You do not have to be AG to take an advanced or accelerated classes
- Advanced classes will be verified by your middle school

Math

- 6th grade Math
 - Math 6
 - Accelerated Math 6
 - O AIMM
- Advanced classes will be verified by middle school

GCS Secondary Mathematics Pathway Options

Below are typical course sequences for taking mathematics in high school. <u>This chart does not include all possible scenarios</u>.

The bolded cell indicates the last HS course the student must complete to satisfy graduation requirements.

While all pathways can be considered by all students, the following table provides possible pathways based on a student's post high school plan and interests.


AG Services

How to Make Course Requests

- Log into PowerSchool <u>Student</u> portal on Feb 14-23
- Easiest to do this on child's school device
- Student ID and birthdate

 Students should Login to <u>NCEdCloud</u> > Access PowerSchool Student Choose <u>Class Registration</u>
The list of course subjects available will appear on the screen.



2. Click the **pencil icon** to the right of the course subject (see directions below) If you Choose Band or Orchestra then select 1 A/B day Encore. All <u>other</u> students should choose 3 A/B day Encores.

All students should choose 1 alternate A/B day Encore that is different than their other encore choices.

Then Click **OK**.

Once courses have been chosen for all subjects, click <u>SUBMIT</u>.
 Selected Course requests will appear and your counselor can now view the requests.
