This letter provides important information regarding the **2024-2025** course registration process at Weaver Academy. The resources and information below will help guide decisions about your child's course requests and help them reach the next stage of academic progress.

Weaver Academy will host *Parent (IN)gagement Night* on Thursday, February 29th 6:15pm-8:10pm. During this time, counselors will be available to answer questions about registration. You may also find information about our school's registration process on the Weaver Academy website.

Your child will register for course requests using the Online Course Registration in PowerSchool. The student online registration window will open from **March 1st – 10th, 2024**. Parents/guardians may review their child's **2024-2025** course requests by accessing the PowerSchool Parent Portal. You may find the parent Portal on our school's webpage by clicking the tab for Parents – PowerSchool section. Your student will meet one-on-one with their school counselor March 11th, 2024 – April 26th, 2024 to review their course selections. Below are some reminders about registration at Weaver Academy including specific instructions for how to register online.

Students will receive a copy of their course requests for the **2024-2025** school year once they meet with their counselor. Please take time to review and discuss your child's course selections. We encourage students to take advantage of rigorous coursework as GCS is proud to offer courses and programs that will prepare students for educational and career opportunities after high school.

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Below are a few reminders and links that will be helpful to you during registration. We have also included instructions for how to select the classes, as well as a list of the course offerings for next year. Counselors will be available during lunch March 4th – 8th to assist students who want help with navigating PowerSchool to select classes.

Reminders:

1. Below under “Links”, students will find instructions for how to select courses through PowerSchool. You must complete this task between March 1st – 10th. **After March 10th, you will no longer have access and only counselors can make changes.**
2. Students will select an English, Math, Science, Social Studies, and arts classes. When you log into your account, you will see course groups for each subject and the options available to you for that area. If you are taking Honors Math III and you are uncertain which math to select for next year, please contact your current math teacher for recommendations.
3. Students will select a total of seven (7) courses. The computer will only allow you to select your principle class one time so your counselor will go in and add the second principle (PVA area) class.
4. If you are interested in taking an online class over the summer, please tell your counselor during your individual meeting. Remember, due to the condensed course load in summer online classes you can expect **three to five hours of work per day**. As a result, the district recommends you only take one online course during the summer term. AP classes are not offered in the summer. We will not know what is offered this summer until April or May.
5. When you meet with your counselor, please know what your alternate is for classes that may be full or not offered. For example, if you select a CTE course you will need a second choice if the course is full with CTE students. You cannot enter alternates in the computer. Please be prepared to share your alternate for any electives you select. (You do not need alternates for your required PVA classes.)
