International Baccalaureate (IB) Programs

IB Program

- Rigorous, two-year program during junior and senior year.
- Students take IB courses and complete a series of oral and written examinations.
- Upon successful completion of the program, IB students will receive an internationally recognized IB diploma.

Students apply and attend GCS IB Programs based on the attendance zone they live in.


