JOB TITLE: ROOFING/PAVING SPECIALIST II MAINTENANCE DIVISION

GENERAL STATEMENT OF JOB

Under general supervision, assists in the general maintenance work required to maintain the roofing and roofing systems, of the various facilities of the Guilford County Schools System in an efficient and safe manner. Work involves performing a variety of repair tasks in roofing, guttering, roofing maintenance, parking lot paving, resurfacing, and concrete surface maintenance. Duties require the application of skills in roofing preparation, tar roofing, shingle, sheet metal guttering, and maintenance. Employee must exercise independent judgment and initiative in performing assigned duties. Tact and courtesy are required in frequent contacts with co-workers and school officials and department heads. Reports to the Roofing Foreman.

SPECIFIC DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

Performs a variety of skilled repair tasks in roofing and roofing repairs.

Repairs various roofing types from shingles to tar or black top roofing.

Performs a variety of repair tasks in concrete, black top or cement paved surfaces.

Troubleshoots and diagnoses problems and makes repairs; performs preventive maintenance.

Request, maintains and is responsible for the inventory and accountability of material, tools, repair parts and equipment assigned and is issued for use.

Inventory all tools and equipment quarterly and submit results via the appropriate supervisor(s) to the Director for consideration.

Have considerable knowledge of the operational capabilities of the District's computerized work order system and is able to provide assistance as needed to subordinates working in the trade.

Must have considerable knowledge of all department operating procedures to include but not limited to the work order procedures, credit card procedures, International Standard Organization (ISO) procedures, and other departmental procedures developed and implemented.

Responsible for the ensuring assigned automotive equipment is operated and maintained as outlined

in applicable district's procedures.

ADDITIONAL JOB FUNCTIONS

Performs other related work as required.

MINIMUM TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE

High school diploma or equivalent, 1 to 2 years of experience in roofing maintenance and or construction, and general knowledge of building trades; or any equivalent training and experience which provides the required skills, knowledge and abilities.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT

Possession of a valid driver's license issued by the state of North Carolina. Must maintain a safe driving record. Possession of a valid driver's license issued by the State of North Carolina. An employee assigned to this position is designated as Category "A." Category "A" employees are governed by Guilford County Schools Policy GA and Administrative Procedure GA-P, "Drug and Alcohol Free Workplace," which spells out specific drug testing requirements, procedures and consequences of positive alcohol or drug tests or arrest for alleged violation of any alcohol or drug-related offense.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS OR STANDARDS REQUIRED TO PERFORM ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

<u>Physical Requirements:</u> Must be physically able to operate a variety of equipment and machinery including hot tar kettles, roof cutters, roof sweepers, ladders, drills, saws, etc. Must be able to exert up to 100 pounds of force occasionally, and/or up to 50 pounds of force frequently, and/or 10 pounds of force constantly to move objects. Requires the ability to climb and maneuver on ladders, scaffolding, and/or in tight spaces. Physical demand requirements are for Heavy Work.

<u>Data Conception:</u> Requires the ability to compare and/or judge the readily observable, functional, structural or composite characteristics (whether similar or divergent from obvious standards) of data, people or things.

<u>Interpersonal Communication:</u> Requires the ability to speak and/or signal people to convey or exchange information. Includes receiving instructions, assignments or directions from superiors.

<u>Language Ability:</u> Requires the ability to read logs, diagrams, etc. Requires the ability to prepare activity logs, etc., according to prescribed formats. Requires the ability to speak to people with poise, voice control and confidence.

<u>Intelligence:</u> Requires the ability to apply principles of rational systems to solve practical problems and deal with a variety of concrete variables in situations where only limited standardization exists; to interpret a variety of instructions furnished in written, oral, diagrammatic, or schedule form.

<u>Verbal Aptitude:</u> Requires the ability to record and deliver information, to explain procedures, to follow oral and written instructions. Must be able to communicate effectively and efficiently in standard English.

Numerical Aptitude: Requires the ability to utilize simple mathematical formulas; to add and subtract; multiply and divide.

Form/Spatial Aptitude: Requires the ability to inspect items for proper length, width and shape.

<u>Motor Coordination:</u> Requires the ability coordinate hands and eyes rapidly and accurately in using hand tools.

<u>Manual Dexterity:</u> Requires the ability to handle a variety of items such as hand tools. Must have minimal levels of eye/hand/foot coordination.

Color Discrimination: Requires the ability to differentiate between colors and shades of color.

<u>Interpersonal Temperament:</u> Requires the ability to deal with people beyond giving and receiving instructions. Must be adaptable to performing under stress and when confronted with persons acting under stress.

Physical Communication: Requires the ability to talk and hear: (Talking: expressing or exchanging ideas by means of spoken words. Hearing: perceiving nature of sounds by ear.) Must be able to communicate via telephone.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

General knowledge of various types of roofing and paved surfaces in the School System and how to repair them.

General knowledge of approved roofing repair methods, practices, code requirements and safety standards.

General knowledge of the tools and equipment used in the installation and repair of roofs and paved surfaces.

ROOFING SPECIALIST II

General knowledge of building trades.

Skill in roof repair and maintenance.

Skill in the use and care of hand tools and equipment necessary to perform roof. installations and repair tasks.

Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships as necessitated by work assignments.
