




To assemble:


Option 1: Print 1 book for each student so that he or she may take it home for review and carryover.

Option 2: Create a re-usable book. First, print and laminate each page - making two copies of the last slide. Next, cut each page (except the last page) directly in half, and bind the pages along the left side. Also cut the 6 photo squares one the duplicate last slide. Then, place the rough side of Velcro (circles work best) in each square on the content slides. Last, place the fuzzy side of the Velcro on the photo squares and attach them to their matching square on the final slide.


