In this class, plagiarism includes...

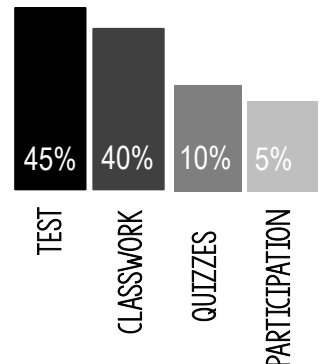
1. turning in another's **work** as one's own
