- Flexible meetings: Meetings will be held monthly to support parent communication, instruction for students, and dialog with administration.
- Involve parents in the development of PFE plan and the Title I program: Parent representatives on the leadership team took part in the creation of the plan for the 2021-2022 school year. Parents are welcome to provide feedback to our PTO, Curriculum Facilitator, Ms. Kelley, and/or our Volunteer Coordinator/Interpreter/Parent Liaison, Mrs. Melara.
- Provide Information to parents: Parents will receive information packets during our annual meeting and during the enrollment process, through weekly Monday folders, scheduled teacher conferences, DOJO daily/weekly communication and during scheduled parent events.
