








# **School Readiness**



# Registration

## Gather Required documents

### Create SchoolMint account

## **Complete Registration**

\*After July 1, SchoolMint registration system will no longer be available.

### **Registering Your Student**



The following information will help you prepare to register your child for kindergarten using the Schoolmint online registration system Your child must be five years old on or before August 31 to enroll.

### **Confirm eligibility**

All Guilford County Schools students must reside with a parent or court-appointed legal guardian who is a district resident.

### Find your child's school assignment

Use our School Assignment Locator at schoolassignmentlocator.gcsnc.com or call the Student Assignment Office at (336) 370-8303 if you need assistance finding your school assignment.

### **Cather required documents**

Parents or court-appointed guardians must submit the following required documents in Schoolmint to register your kindergarten student. Some documents must be requested from your child's health care provider. Collect this information before beginning the registration process to make sure you have everything you need.

- 1. Child's certified birth certificate
- 2. North Carolina Health Assessment Transmittal Form certified by your child's health care provider
- 3. Immunizations (shots) records from your child's health care provide
- 4. Proof of residence showing name and address (CHOOSE ONE): All items below must be in

If you are experiencing homelessness, your child has certain educational rights under federal legislation. Forms and information are available at each school.
