**IV. New Business:**

**Lockdown Drill: (coming soon)**

**EVAAS:** Last year we were D and grew significantly...so we met our goals when you put them all together. Math for 3-5 is blue. Reading 3-5 is green. Met expectations. Want to find a way to celebrate how much growth we've done even though we are still low performing.

- Classrooms are more settled, and quiet and learning is taking place.
- In Math, we are 3rd within Guilford county of 70 schools of highest expected growth. Get books in their hands, let them read. Find ways to connect to their love of reading.
- Keep collaborating and dig deeper. Our working condition survey was great (100%)
- We exceeded our goal and grew 5.5% of our composite.

**SIP Goals**

1. Our goal this year is to grow to at least 44%.
2. Decrease our absences by 5% points from 30.3 to 25.3%.
3. Reading, Math, Science each to go up 3%. We want to get out of the 30s for Science and Reading.
4. Decrease loss of instruction by 10% from 16.82 days to 15 days.

- Dibels we need to get to 70.5%

- Lectura to 53%.

### **Title I Budget**

Tutors: ESSER monies are gone so they looked at our enrollment and we received 2 tutors. They can only be used in K-3 reading. Eason and Whitworth. We are trying to get some extra training for our DL teachers as well as some tutors for the spanish classes.

### **Review Budget**

Vote: Dropping EEA for the DL teachers or take the money to get a tutor for Spanish. Discussion about EEAs for DL. This year, they will not have any additional duties for EEA and will not be required to stay after school on Mondays.

The need for a Spanish tutor is great. Rodriguez made a motion to move the money from EEA to a tutor. If possible get Morrera to tutor DL. Atchison seconded.

Supplies and Materials: We will also need to move money to make up the difference for tutor.

Will be purchasing writing pens for all of the apple iPads as well for all teachers.
