A Peek at the Week

Math: This week, we will be working on using multiplication to solve multi-step word problems. We will continue working with multiplication addition and subtraction.

<u>There will be a Mid-Module Assessment on</u> <u>Thursday.</u>

We are continuing to work with multiplication math facts. Please have your child practice their multiplication math fact.

ARC Skills: This week, we will continue to read informational text on animal adaptations. We will focus on the skills of main idea and how key details support the main idea. We will also dig into informational text structures such as cause and effect, sequencing, and compare/contrast. Students will be taking a mid assessment this week on Canvas for the story *Bone Breakers*.

Reading Groups: Our reading groups will continue researching on their animal for the animal adaptations project. It is very important that every student read informational text daily on their animal. Digital resources are available through Clever and on Canvas. Focus group skills include 3 letter blends, vowel teams, tricky vowels, synonyms and antonyms.
