A Peek at the Week!

Math: Students should recognize angles as geometric shapes that are formed wherever two rays share a common endpoint, and understand concepts of angle measurement. We will measure angles in whole-number degrees using a protractor and sketch angles of specified measure.

Parent Tips!

- Ask your child the **5 W's** after a nightly reading-Who? What? When? Where? Why?
- Practice, with your child, making quarter-turns with your bodies. Stand and face the same wall. Next, close your eyes. Take turns giving a directive to spin 90°, 180°, 270°, or 360° to the right or left. After each spin, open your eyes to see whether you are both facing the same wall. If you are not, discuss who is facing the correct direction.
