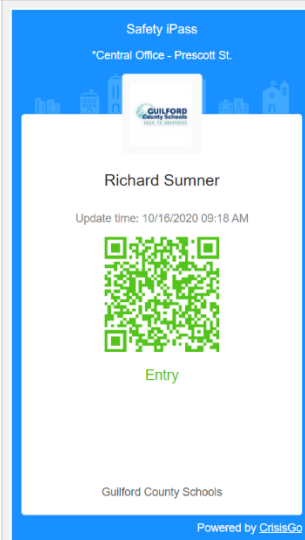

Certification Process

From Web

If you wish to go directly to the web to pre-certify, go to <https://checkin.crisisgo.net/tools/safetycheckin/#/loginByStudent>.

When the login screen appears, click **Sign In With SSO**.

Enter the student's GCS account information. This is the same account they use to connect to remote learning.

Press **Continue**.

A Sign in box will appear.

Enter the student's ID number and password.

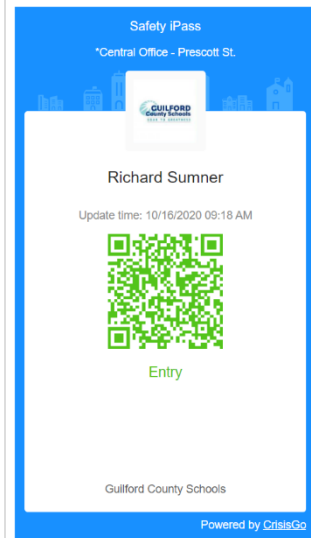
Press **Sign in**.

You will receive an iPass based on your answers. This iPass can be kept open or printed to show to staff upon arrival at school.



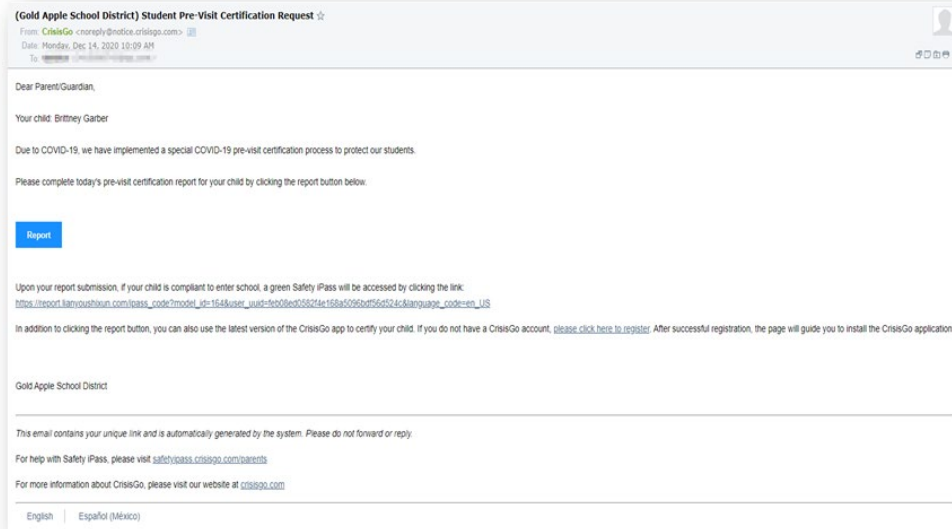

App - CrisisGo for Guardians

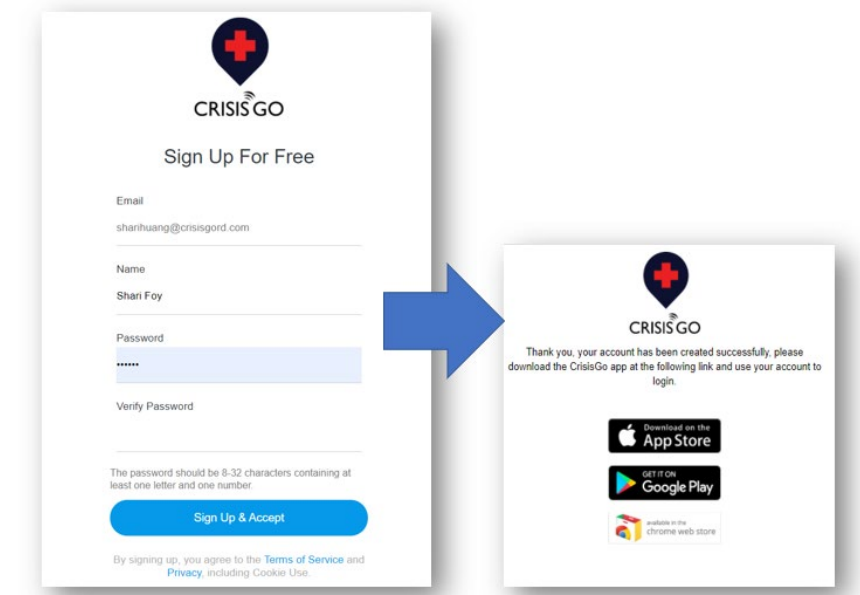
In addition to the option of using the **Report** button in the certification email, parents and guardians can certify students using the CrisisGo app.

Follow these steps to certify your student(s):

Step 1 - Register for an account by clicking the link in the student pre-visit certification email.

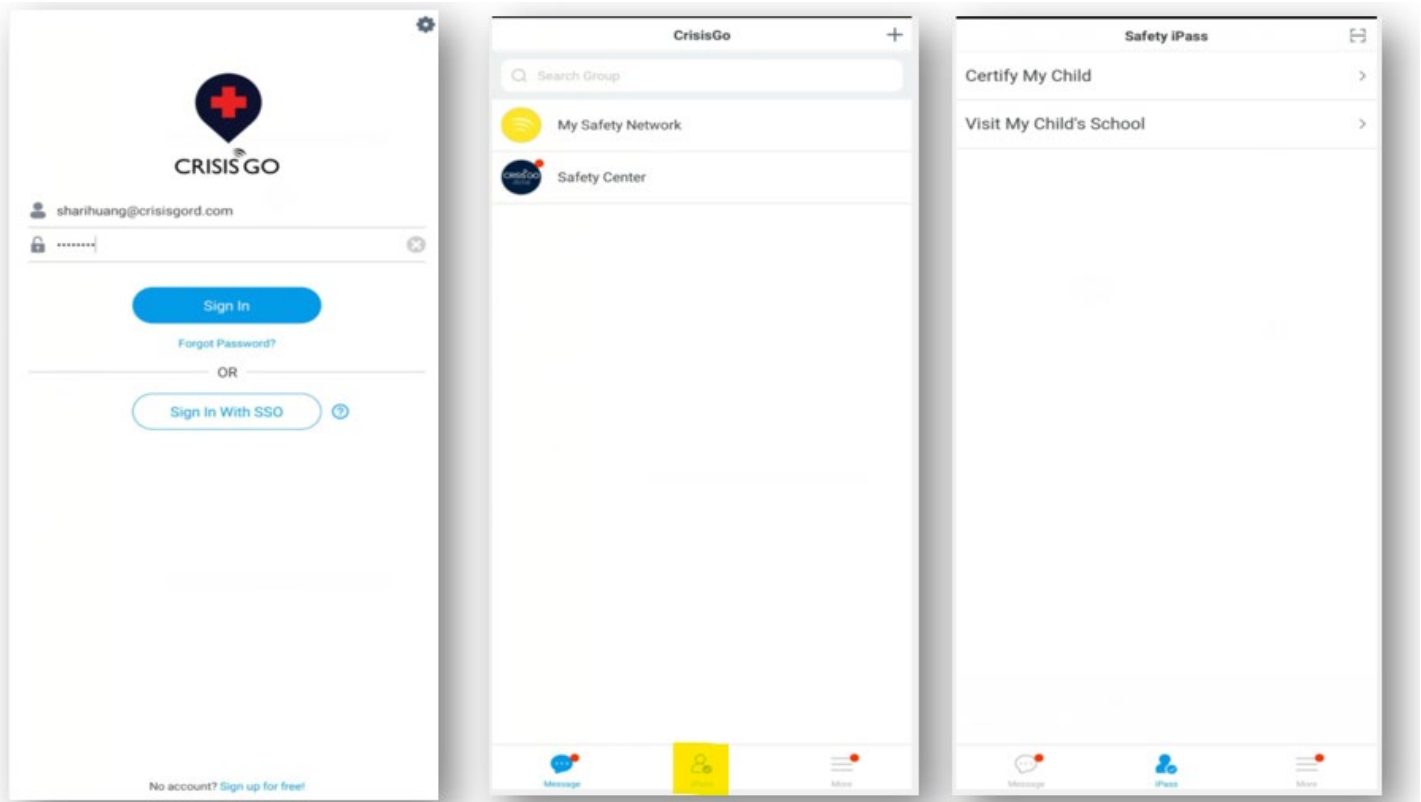


Step 2 - After clicking the hyperlink, your account information will auto-populate on the registration form. The last step in the process is to create a password. Once that has been completed, the page will direct you to install the CrisisGo application.

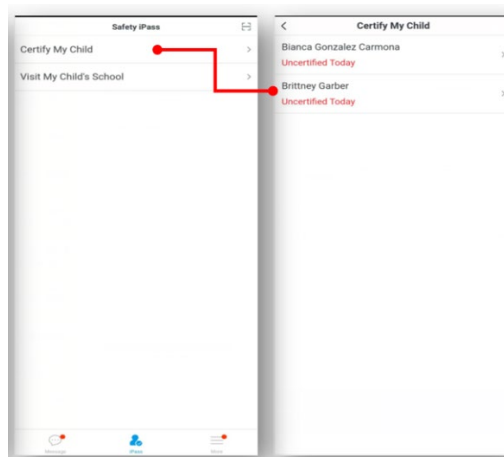

Step 3 - Once you have downloaded the app, log in using the credentials you just set up. Once you are in the app, click the iPass tab at the bottom of the screen. This will take you to the Safety iPass screen.



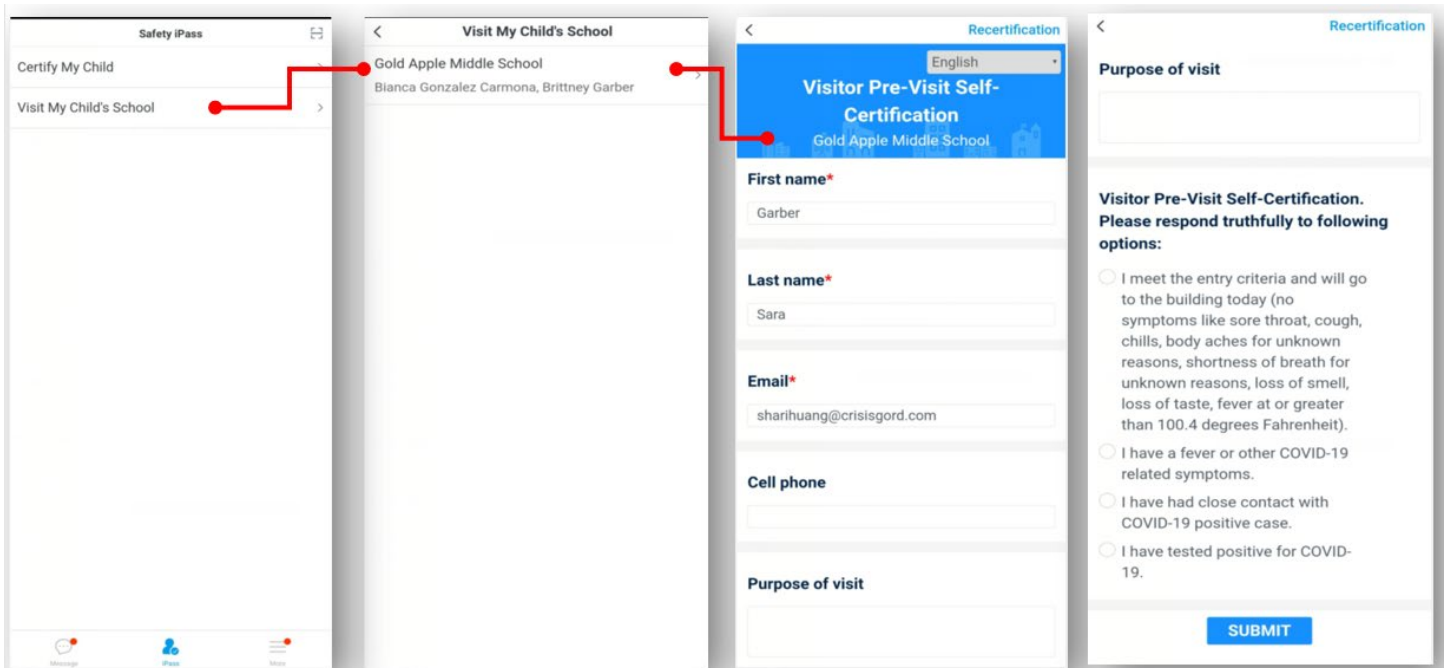
Step 4 - Once you are in the **Safety iPass** tab, you can select *Certify My Child* to view the associated students that need to be certified. To certify, simply tap the child's name and answer the certification questions.

You can also certify a visit to your child's school.






1. Select **Visit My Child's School**

The CrisisGo mobile app can be used by students to pre-certify prior to entry into GCS buildings.





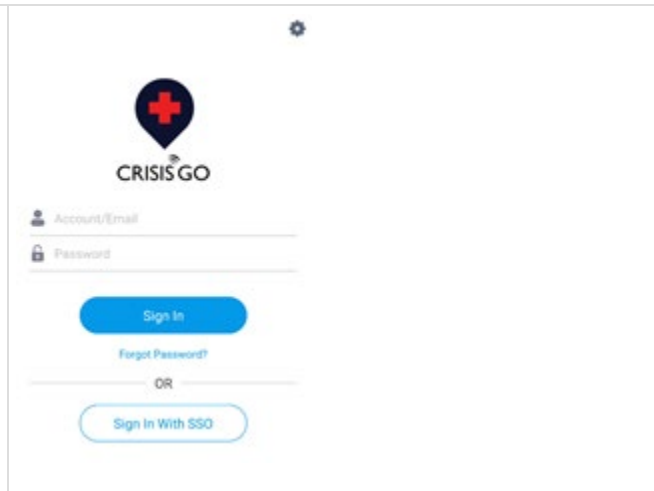
