The applicant must demonstrate financial need, academic achievement, and high moral character. The scholarship is non-renewable.

TO COMPLETE THIS APPLICATION YOU MUST SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION TO THE CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELING OFFICE BY MAY 10th:

1. Send with this Application Form a typed statement (500 words or less) telling why you should be considered for this scholarship, your qualifications, and your educational and career goals.
2. Send with this Application Form a *paper copy* of the **Student Aid Report (SAR)** from the Free Application for Federal Financial Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA is available in paper and electronic formats. You can get the paper version from your high school, the financial aid office at any college or university, the public library, or by calling 1-800-4-FED-AID. Web-based version is at <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov>. *If you do not have a copy of FAFSA, you may send in a copy of your parent/legal guardian's tax return (IRS 1040) for the past calendar year. NOTE: If both parents are responsible for your support and separate returns were filed, copies of both IRS 1040s must be sent.*
3. Have your school send a copy of your completed application and 3 Recommendation Forms (see below) to the High Point Community Foundation, PO Box 5166, High Point, NC 27262.
4. Have three individuals complete and return to the school the Recommendation Forms for the scholarship. Two of these individuals should be current teachers or school personnel and one should be an employer or non-relative residing in Guilford County. Please remind your references to send these forms by the scholarship deadline, **May 10th**.

THE HIGH POINT CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL CLASS OF 1960
SCHOLARSHIP FUND.**

1. Name of the Fund: The High Point Central High School Class of 1960 Scholarship Fund.
2. Projected number of scholarship(s) and amount(s): One or more scholarship(s) per year less than or equal to earnings accrued in the previous calendar year as declared by donors or their representatives in consultation with the Foundation.
3. Criteria of Eligibility:
 - High Point Central High School senior.
 - Good character and citizen.
 - One time award, non-renewable.
 - 3.0 or higher grade point average.
 - Need based.
 - Accredited, academic school.
4. Application process and Selection Committee:
 - Application and selection process will be managed by High Point Central High School.
 - The names and titles of the review and selection committee members will be provided to the Community Foundation annually for Board approval.
 - A copy of all applications and other required documentation will be provided to the Community Foundation prior to the selection of the scholarship recipient.

The Foundation will publicize the availability of this scholarship in its printed materials, will serve as a resource for the Selection Committee, and will distribute scholarship checks to the appropriate institutions.
