- 2. Send with this Application Form a <u>paper copy</u> of the Student Aid Report (SAR) from the Free Application for Federal Financial Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA is available in paper and electronic formats. You can get the paper version from your high school, the financial aid office at any college or university, the public library, or by calling 1-800-4-FED-AID. Web-based version is at http://www.fafsa.ed.gov. If you do not have a copy of FAFSA, you may send in a copy of your parent/legal guardian's tax return (IRS 1040) for the past calendar year. NOTE: If both parents are responsible for your support and separate returns were filed, copies of both IRS 1040s must be sent.
- 3. Have your school send a copy of your completed application and 3 Recommendation Forms (see below) to the High Point Community Foundation, PO Box 5166, High Point, NC 27262.
- 4. Have three individuals complete and return to the school the Recommendation Forms for the scholarship. Two of these individuals should be current teachers or school personnel and one should be an employer or non-relative residing in Guilford County. Please remind your references to send these forms by the scholarship deadline, May 10th.
