Contact Coordinated Entry (Partners Ending Homelessness) to be assessed for the housing list if you are:

- A person who lives in a place not meant for habitation (vehicle, outside).
- A person who is staying in a public or private shelter.
- Remember: Experiencing housing instability, such as facing eviction or having a threat of displacement from a residence, is not the same as experiencing homelessness.
