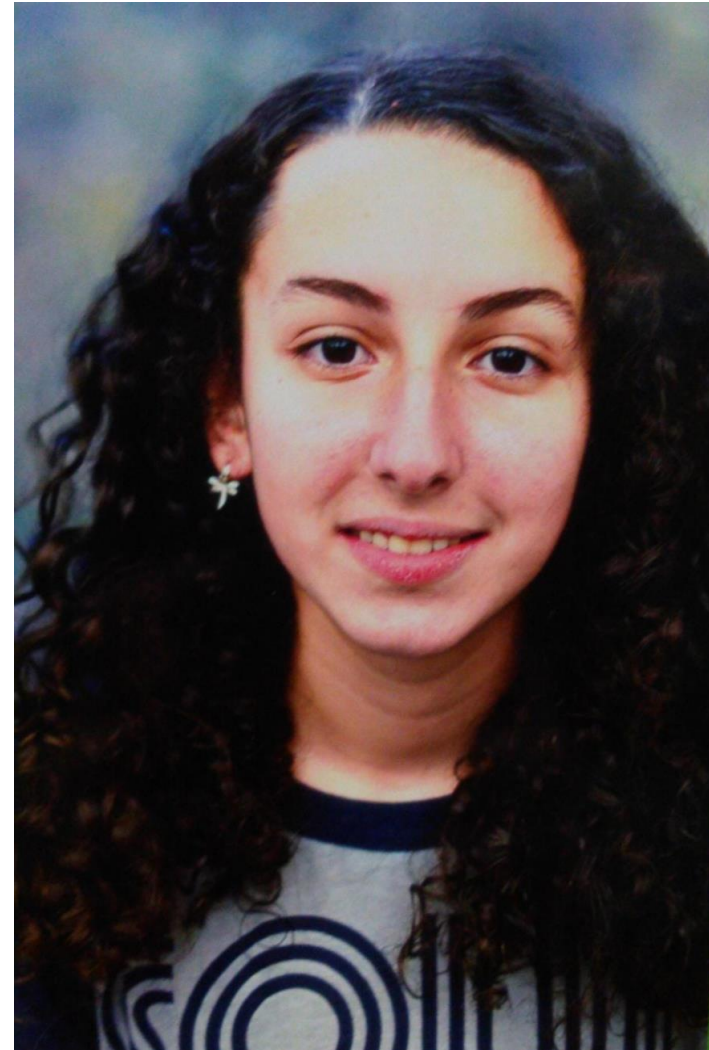


Meet the Kernodle Students of the Month for November 2020

Carson W.

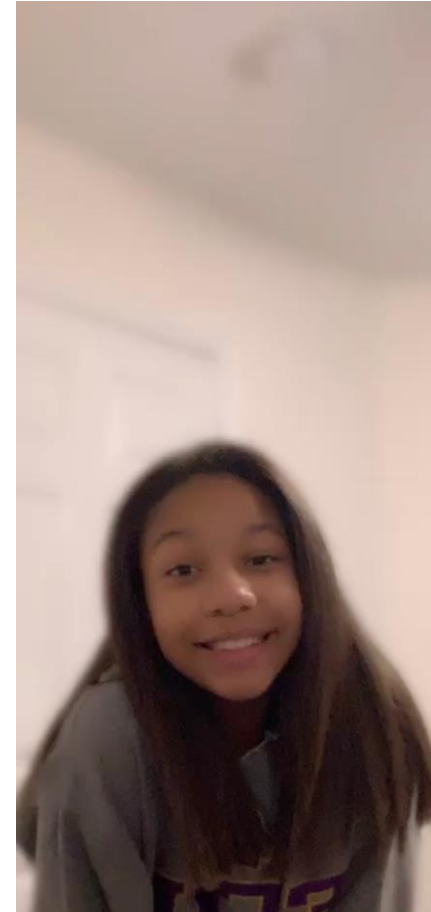
- “I would like to recognize Carson for always coming to class, saying "hello", and asking clarifying questions. Carson is rising to the challenge of virtual learning! “

Kya B.

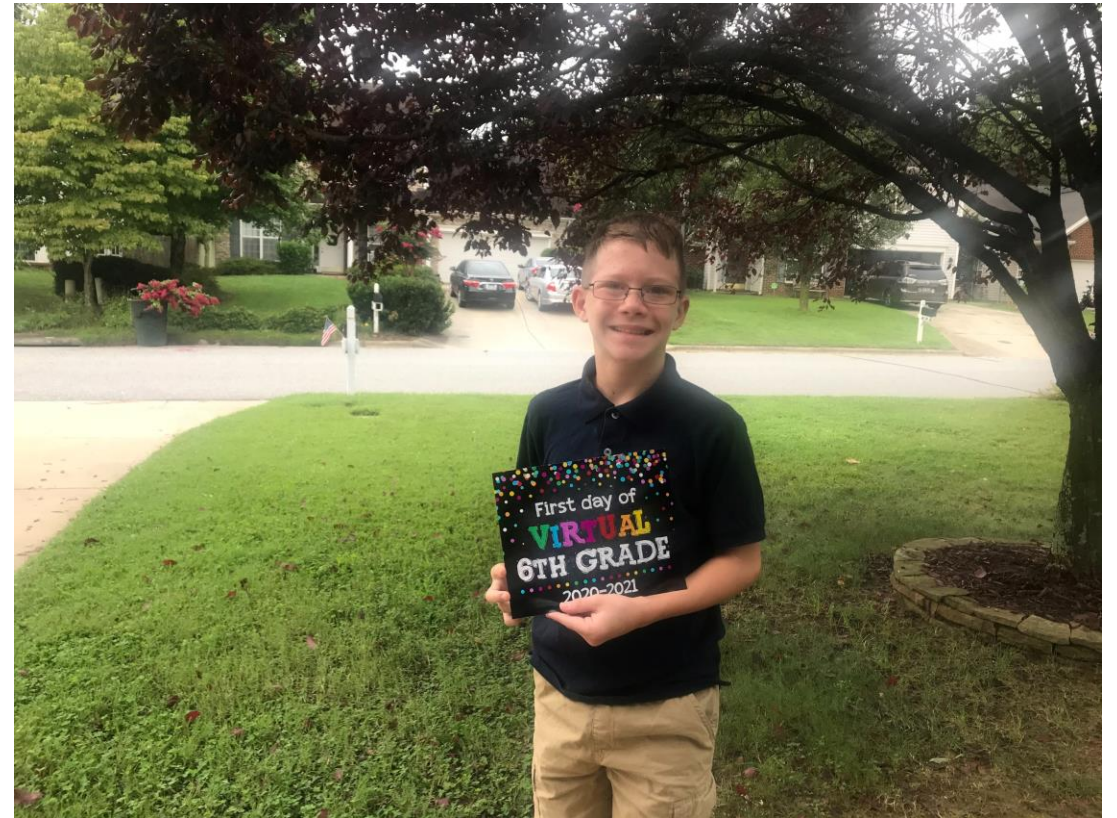
- “I would like to recognize Kya for always coming to class, letting me know of she is having any issues with an assignment, and completing all assignments above and beyond expectations. She is doing great!”

Dallas H.

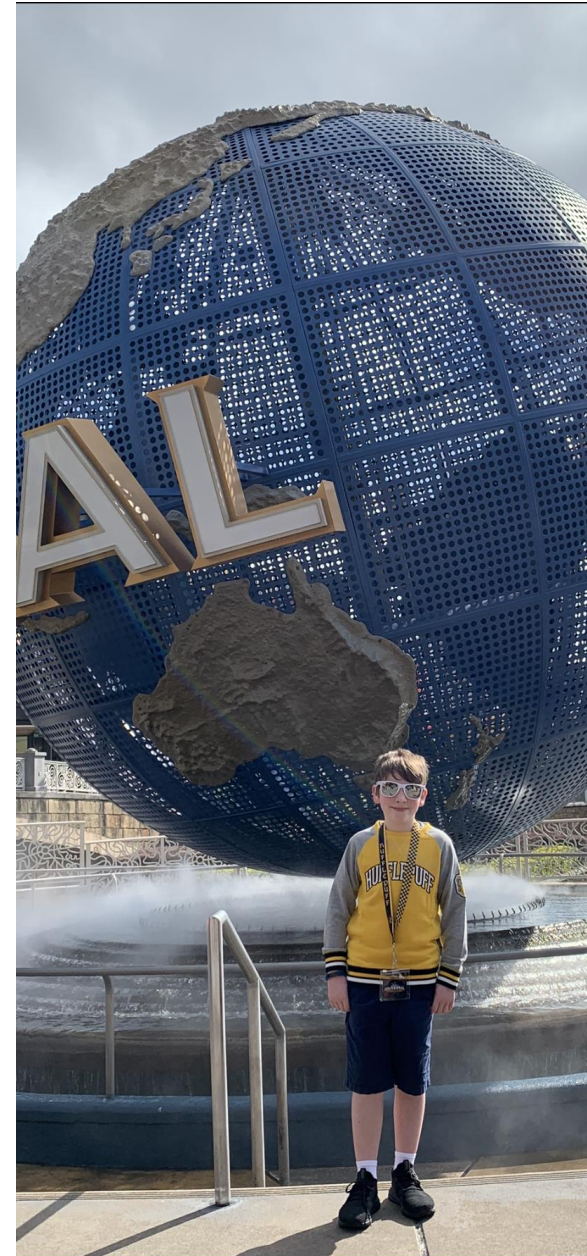
